**Find out how to use the new community
defibrillator**



It takes an ambulance 15-20 minutes to reach Pitstone when you make an emergency call, but your best chance of surviving a sudden cardiac arrest requires treatment within 5 minutes.

Thanks to the Village Health Centre in Yardley Avenue and the local football & cricket clubs, an emergency defibrillator is now mounted outside the surgery. The 999 operator will give you the access code in an emergency.

Everyone should come and familiarize themselves with this new life saving equipment, watch a demonstration, or have a try - you never know when you or your loved ones may need it.
