Pitstone Town Lands Charity provides financial support to people who need help in our community. We offer grants to individual Pitstone residents, as well as local organisations who provide valuable services to them.

- The Charity makes individual grants to local people who need financial support. Grants include the cost of transport to hospital or job interviews, support for further education or training (including books), as well as bereavement grants towards funeral costs.
- The trustees regard people of pensionable age as among those most in need. We assist with grants for glasses, dental care and chiropody. The charity does not make regular payments or fund a higher level than considered necessary by the NHS or other statutory services.
