

Pitstone Neighbourhood Plan

The Pitstone Neighbourhood Plan received was officially 'made' by Aylesbury Vale District Council. 97% of voters in the Neighbourhood Plan referendum held on Thursday 17th March, voted 'yes'. This means that the Village is in favour of Aylesbury Vale District Council using our Pitstone Neighbourhood Plan to help to decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area. Pitstone Safety Scheme

Following an investigation commissioned from Ben Hamilton-Baillie and public consultation, both Pitstone & Ivinghoe Parish Councils are progressing options with Buckinghamshire Council (BC). A Road Safety Audit was then completed and a Feasibility Report has now been undertaken which shows what works would be required and provides an estimated cost. The first phase of works, improvements outside Brookmead School, have been funded and should be installed during 2021. Buckinghamshire Council has not agreed to fund the other works described at the current point in time, and no external grants have been identified.
